Have an Issue/Concern/Complaint??

I wish to remind all residents of Deerfield Lake of the proper procedure should you have any important issues, concerns, or complaints regarding in (or around) Deerfield Lake, including your home area, that the way to go about solving these things is not to offer "vocal" messages to the Office, to the Community Manager, or to Board Members.

The "proper procedure" is to complete a written "Complaint Form," which can be obtained by either going to the Clubhouse, or by going to the Community Office, or see me.

You will need to include such things as

- (1) The address/lot number regarding your issue or concern
- (2) Your name and address;
- (3) Be very specific regarding the nature of the issue/concern.

This allows Management the ability to track and work to resolve whatever the issue or concern may be.


