



DECEMBER FMO UPDATE

Outside of our Homeowners Association, the FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida) is the most important and ONLY organization in the state of Florida that watches over the interests of the residents of manufactured homes located on leased land. The FMO needs our help, our voice, and our support. Basic membership is \$25 a year--- less than 7 cents a day! The FMO is a vital and persuasive advocate, fighting for our rights and doing everything possible to protect the investments we have in our homes and choice of lifestyle. We need to build up membership numbers, for that is what gives the FMO clout with our state legislators.

The next FMO District meeting will be held at Country Knolls in Pompano Beach, on Wednesday, December 9. The Homestead Declaration will be discussed. Filing a Declaration of Homestead protects a manufactured home (on leased land) from forced sale to pay the claims of creditors, including Medicaid. Come and learn about this important provision of Florida law. Forms will be available at the meeting.

Hope to see you at Country Knolls on Dec. 9. Coffee and donuts at 9:30-meeting begins at 10:00. All are welcome!
