
Message from Manny Mirailh - HOA President





The FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida) Update

Agenda will include roundtable discussions of neighborhood watch, rent increase, feasibility of HOA community FMO membership, and the Consolidated Legal Fund.

Become a FMO member!!

The FMO is the only advocate for manufactured/mobile home owners at the state level to monitor and oppose corporations that increase their return every year. For only \$25/year or \$65/3 years, FMO fights for your rights and welfare. Presently, Deerfield Lake has 51 FMO members out of approx. 340 residences. Why join the FMO?

Since 1962, the Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida, Inc. has made great strides for manufactured home owners. Some of the highlights of our efforts are featured below. But as you peruse our accomplishments, remember that the FMO's work affects all manufactured home owners, not just our members. But isn't it better to have a voice in the decision-making process?

#### **Recent accomplishments:**

- Advanced legislation in the Florida House relating to lot rent increases.
- Filed eight House and Senate bills in response to FMO member requests.
- Obtained \$ 2.8 million in the state budget dedicated to the Mobile Home Tie-Down Program.
- Reactivated the FMO Legislative Committee.
- Retained mobile home experienced General Counsel for FMO
- Dissuaded the Florida House & Senate on imposing a tax on rent (this would have increased our rent by approx. \$40/month)

#### FROM THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE

In January, we will be holding elections. A reminder that our By-Laws allow for our Home Owners Association to have a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 7 members. Elections are to select Directors and immediately following the election the Directors will, amongst themselves, decide Who shall hold the office of President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. In the spring, a new addition to our By-Laws now prohibit family members from serving on the Board at the same time.

We urge anyone interested in taking on a meaningful, yet often-times thankless job, by serving your community for the betterment and continuation of our unique South Florida senior park lifestyle, please come to the <u>December 5th HOA Meeting</u>. You must be present at the meeting to be nominated. You must be a bona fide home owner which means your name appears on the manufactured home registration (not just on the rental agreement). You cannot be related to anyone already on the Board or planning to run for the Board.
