May I ask all of our residents to please keep in-mind, the following:

- (1) January 4, 2016; 7:00 PM -- First Board meeting of the New Year!!!
- (2) January 18, 2016; 7:00 PM -- Annual Reorganization Meeting
- (3) Parking Issues There should be no vehicles parked on the grass, for any reason, both day or night. Accordingly, no vehicles should be parked in the Community streets after 11:00 PM at night, or remaining on the street overnight. Our streets are dark and narrow. When parking on the street, even during the daylight, please do not park adjacent to other vehicles. Be sure to keep a "reasonable distance" so any vehicle can get out or get by without a problem.
- (4) Any resident who wishes to report such things as: illegal residents, illegal parking, etc. can obtain a formal "Complaint Form" distributed by Management, from the Clubhouse or the Management office. By doing so, you can be assured that any matter's will receive prompt attention. #### **January FMO Update**

The FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida) is the ONLY state-wide organization that helps to protect and preserve the lifestyle we enjoy here at Deerfield Lake. We have an excellent Lobbyist in Tallahassee, whose job is to represent our interests in issues coming before the House and Senate. In matters pending on our behalf, in order to have something pass, there has to be a support of at least 50% + 1, and the language of the bills must be the same in both. The job of the Lobbyist is to convince the legislators to give their support to us.

Numbers count! It is important that a community have both an active homeowner's association AND a strong FMO support. The FMO needs the financial support provided by annual membership dues of \$25.00--less than 7 cents a day. The greater the membership, the more influence we can have in local and state government.

Many thanks to those who already are FMO members. If you have not yet joined, please consider doing so. Application forms are available at the clubhouse, or I can bring you one. This membership includes a bi-monthly news magazine, which has important info for manufactured homeowners. Prior to 1984 (when Chapter 723 became law), it was mostly "every man for himself" when it came to dealing with park owners. Ours is the most affordable lifestyle in Florida. Help to take it into the future! We can't afford to take these rights for granted! We all benefit from the FMO. Give yourself the gift of a FMO membership!

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
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"A Morning Wish"..... W.R. Hunt
