

Parking Reminder

This article summarizes some of the key points from an October 27, 2016 Management Parking Reminder flyer.

- Residents may only park in space provided by management.
- No Parking on vacant sites, fire lanes, lawns or patios.
- To ensure adequate clearance for emergency vehicles no double parking on the street
- No Parking allowed on streets over night between 11 PM and
 7 AM
- All vehicles operating within the community must obey posted speed limit and traffic signs.

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JANUARY 2017 RIPPLES FMO UPDATE SECTION:

The FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida) Update
District 12 Meeting Minutes from Dec. 14, 2016
Location: Deerfield Lake Facilitated by Jan Klafka.

Attendees: Jerry Durham, FMO Director at Large, John Salvucci, FMO trainer, (9) Deerfield Lake,
(3) Golfview Estates, (2) Everglades Lakes, (1) Sunny South Estates

Discussion:

- * Consolidated Legal Fund Jerry Durham presented reasons why to fund is necessary which includes financial leverage to negotiate with park owners and legal fee coverage for court cases. There is an application form to complete. \$1000 is expected up front, then \$500/year for 4 years. To date, 12 HOAs have committed a sum of \$36,000.
- * Homestead Declaration – Jan Klafka presented. Registering your MH will protect it from being seized in legal actions. Jan/Robin has forms. After completion, they must be notarized and filed at your designated county courthouse.
- * Roundtable presentation by each attending park

Next Meeting: No meeting is scheduled for Jan. 2017. Next meeting is Feb. 8, 2017 at 10 AM at Golfview Estates, 31st Ave, Pompano Beach.

2017 DEERFIELD LAKE HOA BOARD NOMINATION CANDIDATES

The December 5th HOA meeting was the last opportunity for people to come forward and be nominated to serve on the Board. We now have a full roster of seven people for the upcoming elections, which will be held on Monday, January 16, 2017. This meeting is the Annual Corporate Meeting which is a reorganization meeting and different from our regularly held monthly meetings. There will still be an HOA meeting on Monday, January 2, 2017.

Two present members of the Board will continue their term, Manny Mirailh and Sandy Ladue. Maryann Larkin was nominated for another two-year term, she has just completed two years on the Board and will not be able to run again once her 2017-2019 term is up.

Deborah Dane will be running for a one-year term to complete the term being vacated by Marge Reinhardt. If Deb likes serving on the Board she will be eligible to run in 2018 for a two-year term. Deb is originally from Georgia where she worked for Toshiba as a Special Events Coordinator. She also ran a cat boarding business from her home. Deb has lived in Deerfield Lake for three years. She has decided to try her hand on the board because she wants to be more a part of the community, and to help, as well as it being good for her own personal growth.

Robert Schenk came to Florida from Somerspoint, N.J. where he was a food server in a casino. He moved to Florida in 2011 and then to Deerfield Lake in 2012. Robert has decided to serve on the Board because he thinks this is a lovely community and he wants to help to keep it as good as it is.

Nominated at the December meeting were Kathy Trapp and Garner Denmark. Kathy is also from Georgia where she spent 23 years as a mail carrier for the United States Postal Service. Kathy has been living here for two years and wants to serve on the board because she would like to see more people get involved with the community. Garner is from South Carolina where he was a restaurant manager overseeing 40-50 employees. He is now semi-retired, living here for one year. He moved to Deerfield Lake because he has friends living here and would like to be an active part of the community.

With seven members, there will technically not be an "election" since there are no contested positions. However, we will still need a quorum to proceed with the meeting and swear in the new directors. Please make sure to attend the meeting on January 16th. Immediately following the ballot cast for this slate of directors, as per our by-laws and Florida Statute 723, they will go and decide, amongst themselves, who will be our President, V-President, Secretary and Treasurer for the 2017 year.
