REPORT FROM THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE

Monday, January 15, 2018, is the official Home Owners' Association Corporate Meeting, when elections are held for new directors to serve on the board. At our December 4, 2017, Association meeting, two people were nominated from the floor. Lorri Hollingsworth, a snowbird residing at Q-4, moved into the community two and a half years ago. When not in Florida Lorri and her husband Brian live in Seeley's Bay, Canada, which is in Ontario. Lorri retired from being in retail services and is a strong believer in community service. She provided English speaking classes to some of our residents when she first moved into the community. Lorri wants to serve on the board because of her strong belief in giving back. A quorum, as per our Bylaws, consists of 25 people. As per FL Statute 723, requirements for counting a quorum: one person per household, eligible to vote, which means that person's name must be on the deed. We do have more than 25 people attend meetings, but they cannot all be counted, so please, we need more people to attend our meetings.

A reminder that the January monthly meeting, which is always the first Monday of the month, is New Year's Day, therefore the monthly meeting will be held on Monday, January 8, 2018 instead. We will need a quorum! This meeting is the regular monthly business meeting, while the January 15th meeting is just for the election and swearing in the new members.

With this decision, we have avoided having the mobile home bill become a political football between the House and Senate for reasons that have nothing to do with FMO or our legislation.
