Watchdog February 2018:

At this writing, the 2018 Legislative Session is approaching the mid-point. During the first week of February the House and Senate will each pass its version of the state budget for the fiscal year that begins July 1. The Appropriations Committees have each recognized that chamber's priorities and the proposed budgets are approximately \$100 million apart. For perspective, the totals for each proposed budget are more than \$87 billion. You may recall that crafting and approving a budget for the next fiscal year is the only obligation that the state Constitution requires of the Legislature in each Regular Session. Negotiations to resolve differences between the budgets will proceed to have an on-time adjournment on March 9. FMO will be vigilant to maintain funding for both the Mobile Home Tie-Down Program and the Florida Mobile Home Relocation Trust Fund which are both part of the budget.
