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The FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida) Update Founded in 1962

Avoid a PAINFUL increase in the assessment on your leased lot! Vote YES...... Ballot Number 2 Your leased lot is assessed and taxed as commercial property. Assessments on commercial property have been restricted to 10% annually. Property taxes are passed on pro-rata if that is permitted in your prospectus. Amendment 2 must pass by 60% in November or the restriction ENDS!!!

This is the actual language placed on your ballot November 6, 2018:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT ARTICLE XII, SECTION 27 LIMITATIONS ON PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENTS— Proposing an amendment to The State Constitution to permanently retain provisions currently in effect, which limit property tax assessment increases on specified non-homestead real property, except for school district taxes, to 10 percent each year. If approved, the amendment removes the scheduled repeal of such provisions in 2019 and shall take effect January 1, 2019.
