The FMO (The Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida) is the only statewide organization that safeguards our rights as a manufactured home owner in Florida. It is financially supported by its members through a \$25 annual fee. The members also receive a bi-monthly FMO news publication. You are invited to become a member. Contact me for further info.

The FMO was founded in 1962, and was VERY influential in the passage of the Florida Manufactured Home Act (Florida Statute 723) in 1984 and addresses many issues important to us as manufactured homeowners living on leased land. This Statute is updated frequently to keep up with current situations, and is a document that ALL of us should be familiar with. 
<u>The October FMO district meeting will be held on Wednesday,</u> <u>October 14, here, at DEERFIELD LAKE.</u>
