From the Nominating Committee

It is getting to that time when we must elect new Directors for our HOA Board. Elections will be held on the 3rd Monday in January, which is January 15, 2019. The December HOA meeting (Dec. 3rd) will be the last opportunity for a nomination from the floor. In order to run for a seat on the Board the person's name must appear on their manufactured home registration and be present at the December meeting.

We currently have seven Directors on the Board. Our By-Laws allows for either five or seven members. Three Directors will be entering the 2nd year of their two-year term: Deborah Dane, Lorri Hollingsworth and Peter Saunders. Current Directors Thomas Gildersleeve and Sandy Ladue are eligible for another two-year term and have indicated they will be running again. Garner Denmark and Maryann Larkin's terms are up and are not eligible to run again, which leaves two open seats.

As per Florida Statutes AND our By-Laws, elections are held to select Directors. On January 15th, the Annual Meeting is held, it is an organizational meeting. Directly after the election, the Directors will meet among themselves to select officers for the 2019 year. They will select, as per our By-Laws, a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. This reorganization is done on a yearly basis.

We are very fortunate to have had two new homeowners step forward to run for a Board seat. Mark DiBattista moved to Deerfield Lake one year ago come January, from Connecticut. He resides with his wife at U9. Mike has had several careers over the years. He was a police officer, a private contractor and a liquor license enforcement agent. He has experience with negotiations and is interested in joining the Board to help maintain the integrity of the community and to get involved now that this is their permanent home.

Our other candidate is Linda Cammallere who resides with her husband at J11. Linda is brand spanking new to our community having moved here in October from New Jersey. Linda has 10 years of experience being on the Board of her HOA back in New Jersey. She is retired from being a printer utilizing large printing presses making brochures and more for organizations all over the country. Linda is a huge crafter, having brought all her materials, supplies and expertise with her, she would love to start and teach all kinds of craft classes to the community. As we were currently without a Craft Committee Chair, Linda has stepped up and will be a welcome addition.

New Board members have 90 days to receive a mandated training. There is one being held on Wednesday, February 27th from 7:30AM-1PM at Coral Cay Mobile Home Park in Margate. Lunch is not included but our HOA will pay the registration fee.
