

Show me what I want to see I will keep you very close to me









To become a CERT member, residents must attend a City-funded, 5-week CERT Academy which is provided by Coconut Creek's Fire Rescue Department. CERT members assist City leaders at events such as the annual Butterfly Festival and the 5K Butterfly Run.
