Next meeting, December 2nd @ 7pm, Board meeting 6pm



CARBONARA MAC AND CHEESE SOUFFLÉ

Prep 20 minutes Cook 45 minutes Total 1 hour 5 minutes

This Carbonara Mac And Cheese Soufflé the end all of mac and cheese. It's fluffy, puffy, yummy, gooey, cheesy and creamy pasta with crispy pancetta. Need I say more?

Ingredients

- 12 ounce pasta (such as mini pasta shells or elbow macaroni)
- 4 ounces pancetta (chopped)
- 3 eggs (divided)
- 1 tablespoon butter (unsalted)
- 2 cloves garlic (minced)
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 2 cups milk (I used 3.25%)
- salt and pepper to taste
- ½ teaspoon nutmeg (ground)
- 1½ cups Gruyere cheese (shredded)
- 1½ cups white cheddar cheese(shredded)
- 1 tablespoon fresh parsley (chopped)

Instructions


- 1. Preheat oven to 400 F degrees. Butter or grease a 9×13 inch casserole dish.
- 2. Cook pasta according to package instructions.
- 3. Add the pancetta to a saucepan and cook until it browns. Remove the pancetta from pan and place over paper towels to soak up some of the fat.
- 4. Separate the eggs and whisk the egg whites until stiff peaks form. In another bowl whisk the egg yolks and set aside.
- 5. Add the butter to the saucepan and melt. Add the minced garlic and cook until it starts foaming and gets aromatic, about a minute. Sprinkle the flour over the garlic and stir. Whisk in the milk and cook until the sauce thickens and coats the back of a wooden spoon.
- 6. Season the sauce with salt, pepper and nutmeg.
- 7. Add half the gruyere and half the cheddar cheese to the sauce and continue whisking until the cheese melts.
- 8. Temper the egg yolks by adding a ladle of the sauce at a time to the egg yolks and whisking them, add about 3 ladles of sauce altogether. You want to do this to avoid the eggs from scrambling up when you add them to the cheese sauce.
- 9. Stir in the egg yolk mixture back into the cheese sauce. Remove from heat. Fold the egg whites into the cheese sauce. Add the pasta to the sauce and toss gently.
- 10. Start layering the casserole. First, add half of the pasta coated in sauce to the prepared baking dish. Then sprinkle half of the pancetta over the pasta followed by half of the remaining gruyere and half of the remaining cheddar. Now, add the rest of the pasta and then add the remaining pancetta and cheese.
- 11. Bake for 20 minutes until golden and puffed. If you want it more golden you can turn the broiler on and broil the souffle for 2 or 3 minutes.

SCAM ! ALERT

Family Scams

Scammers are good at pretending to be someone that they're not. They try to trick you into thinking a loved one is in trouble.

Once the scammer makes you think they're your grandson and in trouble, they pressure you to quickly send them money. **But it's all a scam.**Your family member was never in trouble.

- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.
- The scammer might tell you it's **important to keep it secret**. They don't want you talking to other family members and friends and realizing it's a scam.
- The scammers will **play with your emotions.** They're counting on you to act quickly to help your family or friend. And they're counting on you to pay without stopping to check out whether there's really an emergency. If you get a call like this, you can be sure this is a scam.

Slow down. Verify.

Example of a Family Emergency Scam Call

Hi Grandpa, it's me.

Sebastian? Is that you?

Yes, it's me, Sebastian.
Grandpa, I'm in trouble, and I need money for bail.

What happened?

Please don't tell
Mom or Dad. I'll get in so much trouble.

Please help me!
