· Kosher salt

• 1 pound dried spaghetti, such as DeCecco

• 1/3 cup good olive oil

• 8 large garlic cloves, cut into thin slivers

• 1/2 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes


• 1/2 cup minced fresh parsley

### **Directions**

Bring a large pot of water to a boil. Add
 tablespoons of



- 2. Meanwhile, heat the olive oil over medium heat in a pot large enough to hold the pasta, such as a 12-inch saute pan or a large, shallow pot. Add the garlic and cook for 2 minutes, stirring frequently, until it just begins to turn golden on the edges-don't overcook it! Add the red pepper flakes and cook for 30 seconds more. Carefully add the reserved pastacooking water to the garlic and oil and bring to a boil. Lower the heat, add 1 teaspoon of salt, and simmer for about 5 minutes, until the liquid is reduced by about a third.
- 3. Add the drained pasta to the garlic sauce and toss. Off the heat, add the parsley and Parmesan and toss well. Allow the pasta to rest off the heat for 5 minutes for the sauce to be absorbed. Taste for seasoning and serve warm with extra Parmesan on the side.
